How It Works

Where it Goes

- 40% goes directly to the classroom to be used by the teacher for field trips, classroom technology or other specialized needs.
- 60% is directed toward the annual fund to cover fixed costs associated with the classroom (heating, maintenance, desks, computers). Your support provides funding for our academic programs while also providing additional monies to assist our teachers with their specific needs.
