**HELLO TO ALL MCAA VOLLEYBALL AND SOCCER TEAMS.** Heritage is looking forward to hosting the Fall State Tournament. We will be trying to keep you up to date with any changes or additions.

**Please make sure your athletes, coaches, administrators, parents and fans are given this letter.**

**Game Locations:** All volleyball matches and soccer games will take place at Heritage Christian School – 4310 Durston Road, Bozeman, MT 59718. Note that passes will only be sold at the front entrance to Heritage Christian School so please enter through there before going back to the soccer field. There will be pass checkers at the soccer field. Overflow parking is available across from Heritage Christian School at Christ the King Lutheran Church each day of the tournament.

**All Conference:** All Conference will be presented after the 5:30 game on Thursday night. Please be present in the gym by 6:30pm.

**Christian Character Awards:** The Christian Character awards will be presented after the 5:30 game on Friday night. Please be present in the gym by 6:30pm.

**Coaches & Administrators Meeting:** Friday, October 21. 8am in Room 130. When we all gather, we will have a short devotion, a brief sharing of information concerning the State Tournament issues/administrative topics, and then we will break off. John Rasmussen and Rupert Alvarez, Heritage Athletic Directors, will lead a time of community building and prayer for those who want to partake. The Executive Council will also be available to discuss any MCAA-related topics and issues.

**Hospitality Room:** Room 130 will be available for coaches, administrators, and referees to meet and relax during the weekend.

**Team Packets:** Each participating team will receive a team packet.

**Entry Fee:** All teams participating in the tournament will pay a \$150.00 entry fee that includes a team roster page with picture in the tournament book. Teams that have not earned a tournament berth may also purchase a roster page in the tournament book for \$150.00.

**Tournament Passes:**

- \* All-Tournament passes available at the gate: Adult - \$25.00 Student - \$15.00
- \* Day passes for soccer & volleyball: Adult - \$15.00 Student - \$8.00
- \* Championship sessions for soccer and volleyball: Adult - \$12.00 Student - \$6.00
- \* Children 6 years old & under will be admitted free when accompanied by an adult.
- \* Everyone is expected to have their passes available so that there will be no confusion on who has paid to get into the tournament.

**Warm-Up Balls:** Warm up balls will be provided for volleyball. You will need to bring your own warm up balls for soccer.

**Locker Rooms:**

**Volleyball:** There will be locker rooms available to volleyball teams in the gym. The home team will have the east locker room and the visiting team will have the west locker room.

**Soccer:** There are bathrooms available in the south hallway that soccer teams may use to change in. The home team will have the east bathroom and the visiting team will have the west bathroom. Take your cleats off if walking inside the building!
