

Head High School Girls and Boys Golf Coach

Job Description

Foothills Community Christian School, a non-denominational private christian school (Pre-K through 12) located in Great Falls, Montana, is seeking a Head High School Girls and Boys Golf Coach for the 2025-2026 school year. Our coaches are expected to be actively engaged in the community of the school as well as embrace the mission and values of Foothills Community Christian School. The role of the Head High School Girls and Boys Golf Coach is to be responsible for overseeing all aspects of Girls and Boys Golf which include but are not limited to: coaching, christian character development and providing direction to student-athletes so that they might achieve a high level of skill as well as an appreciation for discipline, and sportsmanship golf. This job requires you to interact thoughtfully and respectfully with student-athletes, fellow coaches, staff, parents and community as well as follow the mission of the school. Positive communication strategies, organizational skills, and safety awareness are key requirements. The Head High School Girls and Boys Golf Coach reports to the Athletic Director.

Key Elements

1. Follow and uphold the policies and mission statement of Foothills Community Christian School.
2. Plan, organize, and direct the Foothills Community Christian School Girls and Boys Golf Program.
3. Instruct and demonstrate skill sets and techniques necessary for individual and team development.
4. Ensure that team rules and regulations regarding conduct and eligibility of the athletes are clearly communicated and followed.
5. Plan and organize strategies for developing student-athletes in their faith and discipleship.
6. Consult with the Athletic Director regarding any off-season training programs including scheduling dates for summer camps/practices, uniform fitting, and informational parent meetings.
7. Administer informational parent meetings at the beginning of each season for all levels.
8. Create a safe environment conducive to learning and appropriate for the physical, social, and emotional development of students.
9. Work directly with families in reporting injuries, teaching precautions and procedures to ensure staff/student safety and help students prevent injuries.
10. Model good sportsmanship behavior and maintain appropriate conduct towards opposing team, fans, parents, officials, spectators and community.

- Excellent communication and organizational skills
- Be an active member of a local church body
