Safe & Secure School Protocol

Lockdown: Defined as an internal threat and/or immediate threat. No one IN or OUT without administration approval. FOLLOW Lockdown Procedures!

Shelter In Place: Defined as a safety precaution taken for a possible external threat that is NOT an immediate or internal threat. The decision to implement a Shelter In Place shall be decided by school administration or law enforcement.

- 1. Lock external doors
- 2. No one IN or OUT
- 3. Notify phone tree
- 4. Conduct internal class/operations as normal
- 5. Do not release students from school until cleared to do so

Class Hold: Defined as a safety precaution implemented during an incident where students need to be kept in the classroom. The decision to implement a Class Hold shall be made by the school administration.

- 1. Conduct class normally
- 2. Do not release students from classroom until cleared to do so

Release With Care: Defined as a possible threat in the school's neighborhood during arrival or release time.

- 1. Teachers/staff may be asked to escort students to waiting cars
- 2. Teachers/staff may be asked to accompany students home

Evacuation: Defined as an internal threat, such as fire, that requires students and staff to leave the building for their safety.

- 1. At the sound of the fire alarm, assist students to quietly leave
- 2. Leave lights on and close door (unlocked)
- 3. Exit the building by the predetermined route
- 4. Assemble students in parking lot and have them stand quietly until released by the school administration
